Because of the high degree of accuracy of these coordinates, your handheld GPS receiver may not accept the full coordinate value listed here. Round up or down the "seconds" value to store the coordinates. The aerial photomap I compiled makes it pretty simple that you can really just walk to the graves by using the location map that was created.
